Club Rules (revised 04-2021)

In this document, "The club", "Club" or "NCRG" refer to The Northern Corridor Radio Group Inc.

- All members will conduct themselves with decorum with due regard to the club's image and 1 prevailing circumstances.
- 2. Keys and/or other forms of access control for club house and surrounding buildings are controlled by the TREASURER and are available to members after 1 year of financial membership or earlier at the discretion of the committee in extenuating circumstances.
- 3. All members and visitors are required to sign the attendance register at each meeting. All vistors are also required to sign into the visitor's book (located near the main entrance) at every visit outside normal meeting times.
- All Club business is CONFIDENTIAL, all and any items discussed at any meeting or other 4. gathering must not be discussed or otherwise divulged to anyone outside of the membership. The President is the sole authorized spokesman for all announcements and other communications. He may, however, nominate a member to make specific disclosures in connection club events or as part of a reporting function on news broadcasts.
- 5. The Club reserves the right to exclude non-members at its discretion. The attendance at meetings and Club functions by visitors is on the proviso that the person inviting such persons has informed them that this possibility exists. The PRESIDENT'S ruling on any attendance is final and binding to all persons without discussion.
- All visitors and members shall comply with site requirements of Whiteman Park owners and 6. management.
- 7. The Club is not responsible for any member's property left at the club.
- 8. If any club member either brings the Club into disrepute through their public or private actions or causes any adverse publicity or comment to be generated or circulated which tarnishes the Club's image or creates bad public perception of the Club or it's members; then Disciplinary Action may be implemented as listed in the 'NCRG Rules of Association'
- 9. By accepting membership of the club, members also accept that they will abide with the NCRG Rules of Association - Associations Incorporated Act (2015) and the NCRG Club By-laws.
- 10. Any member standing for office at the NCRG will have been a member of the NCRG for a period not less than (3) years with the exception of the following circumstances as determined by the committee:
 - Should an office bearer position not be filled during an AGM
